This survey was conducted using Spectra real time kinematic (RTK) Global Navigation Satellite System (GNSS) instruments. Unless otherwise noted all positions were measured by short baseline Base/Rover RTK solutions and meet or exceed the Relative Accuracy Standards for Land Boundary Surveys as defined in WAC 332.130.085.

The field crew consisted of Bryce Tolton and Duston Galusha. Computing, field crew supervision and the final survey plat was executed by Grant D. Tolton, PLS.




