# DESCRIPTION:

The west half of the southwest quarter (W1/2 SW1/4) of Section Thirty-one (31), Township Thirty-three (33) North, Range Thirty-seven (37) East W.M. (Consisting of 80,02 acres,) Situated in the Coville Indian Reservation, Country of Ferry, State of Washington.
SUBJECT TO covenants or other easements of record.

This survey was performed at the request of Will Evert to survey and post the lines of the W1/2 of the SWI44 of Section 31, T.33 M, R.37 E, W.M. To execute this survey, the retracements of the US General Land Office (GLO) survey and other subsequent privately executed Surveys in Section 31 were necessary.

This survey was executed using Topcon GR-3 real time kinematic (GTK) Global Positioning System (GPS) instrument in conjunction with conventional traverse method using a Leica \*TCR 703 Auto\* total station. Positional error, field traverse, closure and precision meet or exceed requirements of WAC 332, 130.090.
