The following covenants shall be part of this didication:

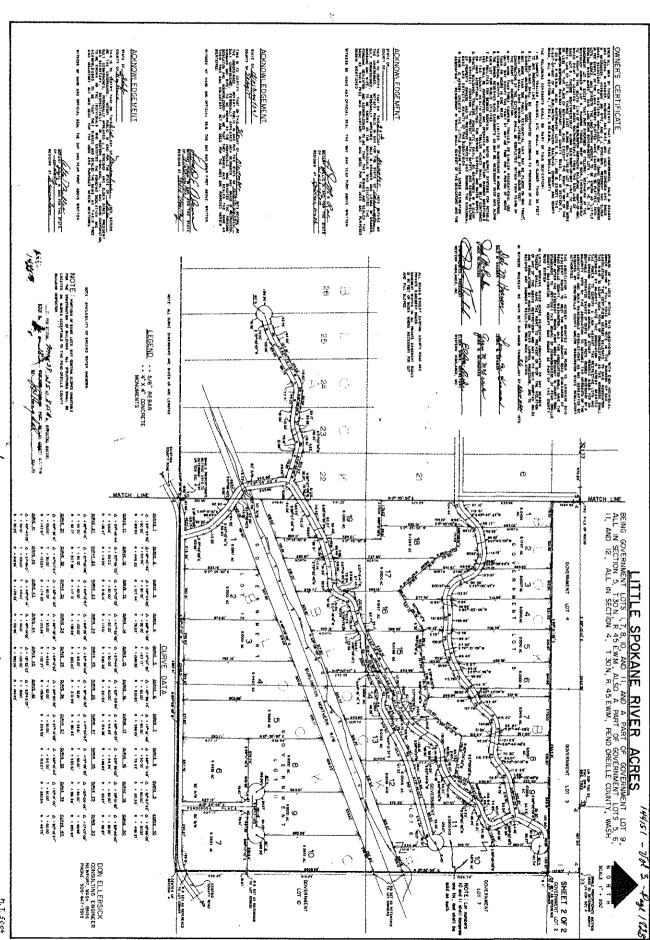
- 1. No camper, trailer, building, etc., shall be set closer than 25 feet to any property line.
- 2. All buildings shall be constructed according to provisions of the current uniform building code.
- Not more than one family residential unit may be placed on one tract, said unit shall have minimum liveable space of 800 square feet. Construction of the exterior shall be completed within four years of the start of construction.
- 4. Not more than three campers, trailer, or similar recreational use units may occupy the tract at any one time for a period of more than 48 hours in one week.
- 5. Commercial activity shall be limited to inobtrusive in home enterprise.
- 6. The owner reserves such easements as may be necessay over and along each lot for public utilities.
- 7. All facilities for sewage disposal and water supply systems for potable use shall be constricted and operated in a sanitary manner acceptable to the County Health Officer. Trailer homes shall be self contained or have acceptable facilities for sewage disposal and water supply.
- 8. Tracts, buildings, trailers, roads, etc., shall be maintained in a clean and orderly condition to protect health, safety, and general welfare of property owners and to preserve, protect and enhance the ecological base and esthetic beauty of this subdivision.
- 9. There is hereby created the "Little Spokane River Acres Recreation Association", membership in which shall consist of the dedicators and the owners of all lots within this subdivision.

- with each individual owner having a full voice and vote in the business of said Association. The certifiers hereby delegate to said Association, the right to adopt such form of organization as the members shall determine by majority vote. The Association is hereby granted the power to certify a lien against the respective lots and the owners thereof on an annual or other periodic basis for an equitable prorated share of costs and fees deemed necessary by a majority vote of the Association to advance the interests of the Association and such reasonable regulations as may hereafter be required by Pend Oreille County and/or Washington State regulatory authorities.

 The Association is hereby granted the power to upgrade said easement roads to meet the minimum county standards
 - The Association is hereby granted the power to upgrade said easement roads to meet the minimum county standards of Pend Oreille County, Washington, and the Association shall have the power after the easement roads have been brought to county road standards to petition the board of commissioners of Pend Oreille County, Washington to accept said roads as part of the county road system.
- 10. Little Spokane River Acres Recreation Association or any member thereof shall have the right to prevent or stop the violation of any of the above restrictions and any of its duly adopted rules and regulations by injunction or other lawful procedure, and to recover any damages resulting from such violation.
