# Black Lake (Stevens County)

Twelve miles east of Colville up Gap Creek Road at 3700 feet elevation. This lake opens the 4th Saturday in April and runs through October 31. Tiger trout (a Brook Trout x Brown Trout hybrid - first planted in fall of 2002) are planted annually and continue to provide an interesting fishery in this lake. Rainbow Trout are also occasionally stocked to provide additional variety and opportunity.

Black Lake is a lake located just 12.9 miles from Colville, in Stevens County, in the state of Washington, United States, near Park Rapids, WA. Fishermen will find a variety of fish including perch, crappie, cutthroat trout, largemouth bass and bullhead here.

Black lake offers peace & tranquility along with pristine wilderness & wildlife. This 70 acre, "no wake" lake offers spectacular trout fishing during the spring & summer months together with access to hundreds of miles of groomed snowmobile trails in the winter months. A true year-round recreational destination; Black Lake sits at 3,700 ft in elevation, is surrounded by thousands of acres of Forest Service Grounds & is neighbored by the Twin lakes just a mile or so away and the Pend Oreille chain lakes just 7 or 8 miles up the HWY.
